BYLAW NO. 07-004

A BYLAW OF THE LAC LA BICHE COUNTY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO REQUIRE THAT ALL NOMINATIONS BE ACCOMPANIED BY A DEPOSIT.

WHEREAS, Lac La Biche County deems it appropriate to establish procedures for the conduct of Council meetings; and

WHEREAS, Section 29 of the Local Authorities Election Act, Chapter L27.5, R.S.A. 2000, and amendments thereto provide for the passing of a bylaw to require that every nomination be accompanied by a deposit,

NOW THEREFORE, LAC LA BICHE COUNTY COUNCIL, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, DULY ASSEMBLED ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. THAT every nomination pursuant to the Local Authorities Election Act, L-21, R.S.A. 2000, and thereto be accompanied by a deposit.
2. THAT the deposit be in the amount of one hundred (\$100.00) dollars.
3. THAT the deposit is to be provided in cash, debit, certified cheque or cash order or by money order.
4. THAT the disposition of the deposit be made in accordance with Section 30 of the Local Authorities Act.
5. THAT Lakeland County Bylaw 98-002 is hereby rescinded.
6. THAT this Bylaw takes effect on the date of final passing.
